Happy Tails: Morgie & Cali

For those of you wondering about those four kitties whose owner passed away and were in need of new homes, two were adopted by the previous owner's son. Here's an update on the other two.

A friend of a friend can sometimes create a wonderful change in someone's life. And that's exactly what happened to Shelli and her partners' lives about a month ago.

"I miss not having a pet in the house", Shelli told her partner one day. As luck would have it, looking at Facebook posts from various friends, Shelli came across one that mentioned two older cats needing a new forever home. They had belonged to the mother of Shelli's friend of a friend whose mother had passed away. So on July 24th, Mr. Morgan Freeman (Morgie) and California (Cali) moved to their new home.

Morgie, a 15-year-old, is a "big, orange boy who just loves to eat, sleep, and cuddle", according to Shelli. He arrived quite overweight so Shelli has been working with Rock Island Animal Hospital to safely get some pounds off of Morgie. Reducing the amount of his food and finding interesting toys for Morgie to actively play with has helped a lot. Morgie also suffers from bad arthritis, so he receives laser treatments and steroid shots, which Rescued has helped pay for. Shelli also stated that Morgie "is very intelligent and knows that the only food he should eat is Purina One Hairball Preventive".

Cali is 13 years old, possibly a Turkish angora or a calico, weighs about seven pounds, and is "very demanding, plays a lot, and is 100% lap kitty" says Shelli. Cali has some arthritis, but a pet heating pad has helped. And she's very specific about treats, which must be Temptations Original Tasty Chicken. Both Cali and Morgie agree that nothing is better than curling up on someone's lap and listening to Deep Focus on Shelli's playlist.

Rescued paid for the initial needed supplies for Cali and Morgie in their new home, including a litter box, food, treats, and toys, which Shelli was very grateful for. Shelli knows that adopting these two sweet and affectionate senior kitties means their time together might not be as long as she would like. However she's glad to share her life and home with Morgie and Cali for as long as their quality of life remains good.
