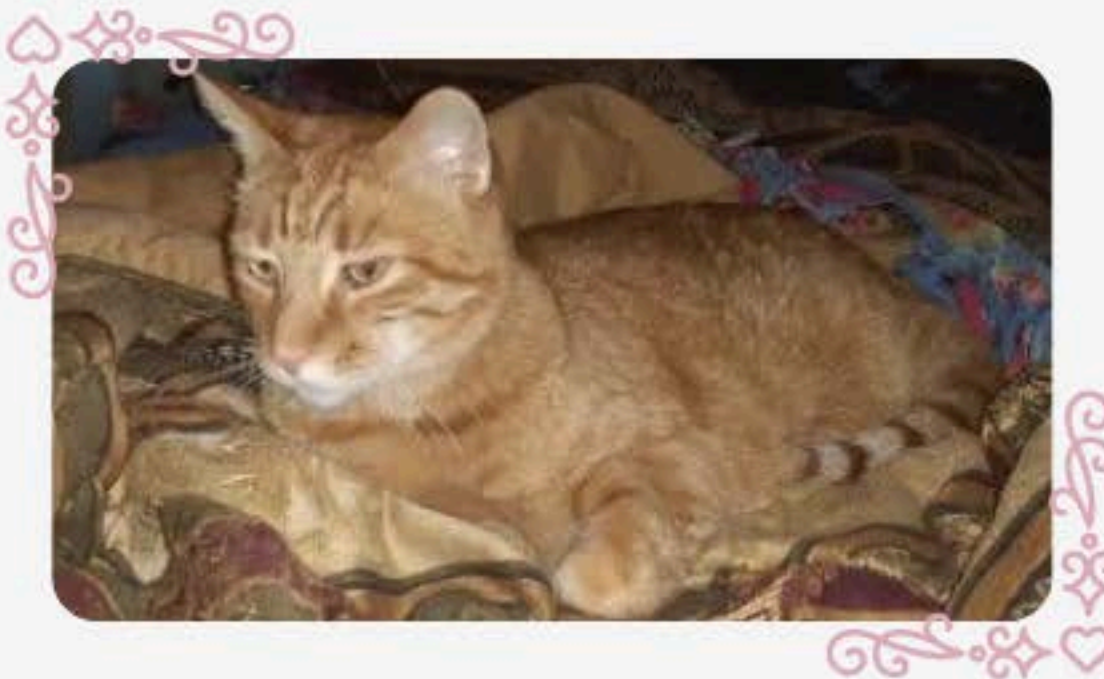
# HAPPY TAILS: PRINCE

Meet Prince, a beautiful 7 year old tiger stripe kitty who was rescued, bottle fed, and raised by Kristina Burke. And until this past month Prince had been the picture of health.

That's when Kristina saw Prince lying on his side, unable to pee, crying and yowling in distress. Kristina knew that Prince needed to be examined by a veterinarian but didn't know how she would be able to pay for this. She posted a request on Facebook asking if anyone knew of any where she might be able to receive some financial help for the veterinarian exam. Kristina had decided that if there was no help available she would have sweet Prince put down rather than allow him to suffer.

But to her surprise multiple responses came back telling her to contact Rescued, which she did immediately. Kristina spoke with Erin who told her to get an appointment with a veterinarian to find out what was happening with Prince. Whitehaven Veterinary Clinic performed the exam and determined that Prince had a urethral stricture which prevented him from urinating. This condition is extremely painful and if not treated within a few days can cause death. The veterinarian inserted a catheter to remove the built up urine and remove the blockage. Prince stayed at the Clinic for 3 days and was sent home with medicine to help prevent spasms and to calm him.



Unfortunately, poor Prince had to go through this treatment twice. The total cost for his care was over \$900, however, an anonymous donor paid part, a Care Credit account was set up, and Rescued covered over \$400.

Prince is currently doing very well. He is now only fed a urinary health food and has his own fresh water fountain to encourage him to drink more water. "How amazing it is that Prince is with me and I didn't have to do what I didn't want to do, by having him put down. Everyone at Rescued are angels in my eyes", Kristina commented.

We wish handsome Prince a long and healthy life!
